A sports medicine trainer will be onsite one hour before play until end of play each day

Hospital serices will be available 24 hours a day. Teams must have medical insurance in the event of requiring hospital treatment

The massage therapist will be available from Monday 23 September

## **FORMAT OF PLAY & MATCH FORMAT**

16 teams will be split into four groups of four. The top two teams from each round robin group will progress to the quarterfinals. The third and fourth placed teams from each group will play off for 9th-16th position.

Three days round robin followed by three days knockout. Each tie will consist of 2 singles matches and 1 doubles match. The doubles match must be completed even if the score is 2-0, unless otherwise decided by the Supervisor. All teams will play 6 ties.

Each main draw singles match (round robin, quaterfinals, semifinals, finals and third place playoffs) and relegation (16th place) playoff singles match shall be the best of three tiebreak sets, unless otherwise approved by the ITF. All other playoff matches shall play two tiebreak sets and a match tiebreak instead of a third set.

In doubles, No-Ad scoring shall be used and a 10 point Match TieBreak will be played if the score reaches one set all

For all singles and doubles matches the No Let Rule shall be in effect

There will be a Chair Umpire for each match

Six new practice balls will be issued to each team captain on arrival on 22 September

Team may pick up new cans of practice balls each day of competition

Towels will be available for pickup at the Player Services desk and must be returned on conclusion of the match

Stringing will be available onsite at a cost of 15USD

Massage costs 40USD for 30 minutes. A sign-up sheet will be available at the Player Desk each morning

Laundry service will be provided onsite. The price is TBC

Bottled water will be provided on court only. Water fountains can be found across the site.
