'Shimadzu All Japan Indoor Tennis Championships', KYOTO, Japan; 4-10 March
'Nova Challenger', OSAKA, Japan, 11-17 March

Players participating in BOTH the above events need only make ONE application for a visa as follows:

1. Complete the form below and fax it to the Japan Tennis Association (81 3 3467 5192) as soon as possible.
2. The Japan Tennis Association will mail you an ORIGINAL letter of invitation. This may take up to two weeks.
3. The player should take the original letter of invitation, plus passport and two identity photographs to the nearest Japanese Consulate.
4. A visa will be issued within 7 days. Nationals from China and the former Eastern Bloc countries should allow 2-3 weeks for their visa to be issued.

Players who are entering KYOTO only should proceed as described above. Players who are entering OSAKA only, should complete the attached form and fax it to PRO TENNIS NIPPON (81 3 5731 6502). PRO TENNIS NIPPON will issue you with an original letter of invitation. Players should then follow steps 3 & 4 as above.

Players should present their application for a visa at the nearest Japanese Consulate **no later than 11th February 2002.**
