Please send an invitation letter to the tournament organizer with passport information and a copy of the passport. Players from Russia, former USSR and China need to allow 2-3 weeks for the visa to be processed. If there are any accompanying persons, they must also submit copies of passports.

Players must apply for invitation letters AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT. For F1-F3, the deadline is 7MARCH.
