ATTENTION TO ALL KANGAROO CUP INTERNATIONAL LADIES OPEN TENNIS PARTICIPANTS

HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR WORKING VISA:

All players who will be participating in Kangaroo Cup International Ladies Open Tennis as a professional status must fill in the visa documents provided by the tournament and the visa application form provided at the Japanese Embassy or Consulate. Please be sure to attach your photos. The Japanese Embassy or Consulate will not accept the copied documents or documents send by fax. They will only accept the original documents.

- Players from a free nation will be allowed about one week to obtain your visa.
- Players from China, Russia, former USSR, Cuba, East European countries, Vietnam, Mongolia, and other former communist countries will be allowed at least 3 weeks to obtain your visa. Therefore, please be sure to apply for your visa in advance.

IMPORTANT

1. Players from a free nation.

You must type up upon filling out the Document 2(Guarantee Letter) and take them to the Japanese Embassy or Consulate. In case the document is not typed up, you will be inquired whether you were invited to participate in the tournament.

If they find out that the document had been filled out by the applicant, then they will not accept the documents.

Therefore, you must type up upon filling out the Document 2(Guarantee Letter) in order to avoid a problem.

2. Players from China, Russia, former USSR, Cuba, East European countries, Vietnam, Mongolia, and other former communist countries.

You must give your full name, birthdate, nationality, and passport number to Gifu Events & Sports Promotion Foundation by fax (Fax# 81-58-231-3484) in order to get your visa documents. Please send it by 31 March.

Please do not forget to give us your address so that the tournament will be able to forward you the necessary documents for you to take the Japanese Embassy or Consulate. Gifu Events & Sports Promotion Foundation will type out the necessary information and forward you the documents to your address.
